

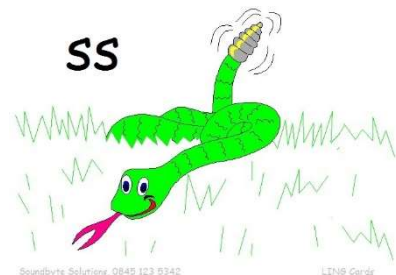
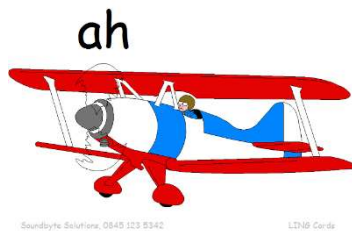
Ling 6 Instructions



Performing the Ling 6 test

This test presents six phonemes which are broadly designed to represent the speech spectrum. It provides a quick and easy screening tool which can be performed on children as young as two or when other tests are not suitable. The phonemes are:

Ling 6 sounds
EE
AH
OO
SH
SS
MM



Prepare the cards by placing them on the table. Ask the child to point to the card when they hear the associated sound. Then, ask the child to imitate the sound that they have just heard. The sounds should be presented at different levels and the responses recorded.
